

Case Study - St Paul's Catholic School





Introduction to company

St. Paul's Catholic School provides secondary education for around 1,600 pupils aged 11-18 from Milton Keynes and the surrounding area.

The school motto is 'Doing the best that is possible'. This is clearly carried through in the way that the teaching staff and pupils work together as, according to the 2005 OFSTED report, "St Paul's Catholic school is an outstanding school which provides excellent care, support and guidance for its pupils and enables them to achieve very high academic standards."

The Challenge

'Doing the best' also extends in to the management of the school, particularly where pupil and staff health and safety are concerned.

"We have a very large site to manage," said Bob Farley, Business Manager, St. Paul's Catholic School. "So instant and reliable communication is essential. That's why we have implemented a radio network solution rather than relying on landlines or mobile phones."

The school has had a radio system in place for a number of years using PMR 446 analogue handsets. However, the handsets were getting quite old and the batteries needed replacing on a regular basis.

Things came to a head in 2006 when two new buildings were added to the site which adversely affected radio coverage.

"The new buildings were of a different construction to the existing ones and were causing a problem for us," continued Bob. "Their metal roofs were interfering with the signal from some locations. Combining this with the reliability issues that we faced with our old handset, we decided that it was time for a change."

The Solution
